- Design, develop, and maintain automated test scripts for React Web applications using Selenium tool and Flutter mobile applications using BrowserStack or similar for Android & iOS platforms.
- Implement and optimize test frameworks and tools to support automated testing.
- Ensure comprehensive test coverage by writing and executing test cases for new and existing features.
- Perform functional, regression, performance and compatibility testing of web and mobile applications.
- Identify, document, and track software defects and inconsistencies using Jira or similar bug tracking tool.
- Collaborate with developers and product managers to understand product requirements and translate them into test plans and test cases.
- Integrate automated tests into CI/CD pipelines to ensure continuous testing and faster release cycles using tools like Jenkins, Gitlab.
- Work with DevOps teams to ensure smooth and efficient build and deployment processes.
- Advocate for and implement best practices in test automation and software quality.
- Work closely with cross-functional teams, including developers, product managers, and UX/UI designers, to ensure high-quality deliverables.
- Provide technical guidance and mentorship to junior SDETs and QA team members.
